

2004 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2004 Cabernet is 100% Rutherford fruit, sourced from two vineyards, one on either side of the valley floor. Gustavo used French yeasts that he believed would enhance the micro-elements and tastes that make the Rutherford area so famous. Hence, this wine really reveals layers of cherries, mushrooms and the classis 'Rutherford dust'. The wine went through an extended maceration - to make sure we got every drop of flavor out of these wonderful grapes - for 15 days before being aged in French oak for two years. The wine was bottled in October of 2006 and has been bottled aged for 15 months before release. There were 285 cases produced.
